

Can solar panels be mounted on a wall?

So, although it is possible to mount solar panels on a wall, it's not ideal. You're also less likely to be able to mount as many solar panels on a wall as you would on a roof, which means they won't generate as much electricity as a roof-mounted system. How far from the wall can a solar panel be mounted?

Without projecting a panel beyond 200mm from the wall, from the wall, you can mount a typical panel with dimensions 170cm by 110cm at around 80°;. A wall-mounted panel gives much better consistency and peaks in spring and autumn compared to the summer. Yearly production ~290kWh. There are multiple options for mounting panels on a wall.
