Who governs Christmas Island in Australia?

An administrator appointed by the governor-general represents the monarch and Australia and lives on the island. The territory falls under no formal state jurisdiction, but the Western Australian government provides many services as established by the Christmas Island Act.

Is there a bank on Christmas Island Australia?

There is only one bank on the Island owned by Westpac, however cash can be withdrawn if you spend over \$20 in the supermarket or from the post office located just above Flying Fish Cove. Christmas Island Australia is remote and all supplies - food, drink, fuel, products etc - have to be imported.

What is Christmas Island Australia like?

Christmas Island Australia is remote and all supplies - food, drink, fuel, products etc - have to be imported. Air freight is meant to arrive every few weeks, and the shipping container with bulk items/products is meant to arrive every few months but can be delayed due to a number of factors.

The Territory of Christmas Island is an Australian external territory in the Indian Ocean comprising the island of the same name. It is located approximately 350 kilometres (190 nautical miles) south of Java and Sumatra and about 1,550 ...

However young Christmas Island red crabs all have the characteristic narrow abdomen of the male. The broader abdomen on the female Christmas Island red crab only becomes apparent in the third year of growth. Christmas Island red crabs grow slowly, reaching about 40mm in carapace width after 4-5 years.

A pristine area of forests, gorges and freshwater streams, the Dales is an internationally significant wetland and one of Christmas Island's most iconic sites. The Dales is located on the western coast of the island. It is home to seven watercourses, three of which have springs and flowing water all year round.
