

Guernsey is seeing an increase in demand for solar panels to be installed on houses with homeowners looking for cheaper energy alternatives. There is now a six-month waiting list for islanders to...

5 ???· St Martin's Parish Hall and its adjoining outside toilet block have had solar panels installed as part of a push to move away from using electricity from the grid, officials said.

Since 2018, the family-run CP Solar Resources Ltd has installed systems that generate a combined 25 megawatts of electricity, output it now plans to double over the next three years, at a cost of almost 4bn shillings (\$30m).

In 2023 Guernsey Electricity worked in conjunction with The Little Green Energy Company to install the vast community-scale solar array at Grow Limited's newly redeveloped headquarters. The 310 photovoltaic (PV) panels will produce 129-kilowatt peak power (kWp). That's enough electricity to supply power to approximately 35 homes.
