What is the cost of maintaining solar panels?

To keep solar panels in good condition and ensure they continue to provide benefits, regular professional cleaning and inspection are necessary. The average cost for maintaining a 10-panel 2 kW solar system on a one-story home is between \$300 and \$700, with most homeowners paying approximately \$400.
