Romania's energy sector is key to its evolving economy and security policy. It has a diverse energy mix, including coal, natural gas, nuclear, hydroelectric, and renewable sources. The largest share of electricity production historically came from coal and natural gas, followed by hydroelectric and nuclear power.

Romania's energy strategy reflects the vision of the Romanian authorities for the sustainable development, economic growth, and accessibility of the energy sector. This strategy is being implemented in the context of the new legislative package for clean energy for all Europeans 2030 and the European Ecological Pact 2050.

What are Romania's energy plans?

Its ambitious energy plans include completing two of the Cernavoda plants and leading the way into a new type of nuclear technology called small modular reactors. It also wants to take full advantage of substantial offshore gas fields in the deep waters of the Black Sea. Two reactors at Cernavoda meet about 20 percent of Romania's energy needs.

To improve energy security in Romania, it is recommended to: Increase the quality of education in the field of energy and continuously train qualified human resources. Also, Romania should aim to be a regional energy security provider. Lastly, Romania can increase its energy contribution to regional and European markets by capitalizing on national primary energy resources.
