

What is the Eswatini tree Atlas?

The main objective of the Eswatini Tree Atlas was to produce a compilation of distribution maps for individual tree species including a few selected shrubs and climbers, detailing their distribution, abundance, habitat, relationship with land tenure, conservation status and use relative to the country.

How many trees are there in Eswatini?

A total of 632 trees were recorded during the Eswatini Tree Atlas project, with 35 exotic and 597 indigenous species, representing just over 17 percent of Eswatini's indigenous flora. The highest numbers of species are found in the Lebombo mountains in the east, near Lufafa peak in the north-west and Sinceni mountain in central Eswatini.

How many mammal species are in Eswatini?

There are 107 mammal species in Eswatini, of which one is critically endangered, two are endangered, five are vulnerable, and four are near threatened. The following tags are used to highlight each species' conservation status as assessed by the International Union for Conservation of Nature :

Does Eswatini have a flora?

On a regional scale Eswatini supports a relatively diverse flora. In comparison with Mpumalanga and Kruger National Park which together have over 950 species of trees and shrubs documented (Schmidt et al., 2002), Eswatini which is barely the size of the Kruger Park boasts more than 630 species.

What is Eswatini known for?

How many taxa are there in Eswatini?

Current checklists for Eswatini's biodiversity include about 8150 taxa, and it is expected that this number will grow as more information is compiled and further investigations are undertaken.
