

Does the government offer free solar panels?

The government does not have any programs that offer totally free solar panels. However, several state and federal government programs can help you access solar energy equipment with lower upfront costs. Are free solar panels a lie?

While the word "free" implies there are no associated costs, this is not usually the case with free solar panel offers. "I have never seen an advertisement offering free solar that is not a lie," said Neil Gallagher of Brighterway Solar, a solar installation company in Florida.

Does the US government buy solar panels?
