Bboxx has been operating in Togo since 2017 and as a key partner in the CIZO programme, it has already supplied electricity to 26,000 Togolese customers. Bboxx has opened around 20 shops, employing around 100 people in Togo. Its solar home systems include solar panels supplied with batteries to store electricity and payable with mobile money.

This intervention precedes a newly signed partnership between Bboxx and Bralirwa to provide solar electricity to 59 additional homes in Ngororero District, also in Western Rwanda. The 59 homes were selected in partnership with the district authorities, and installations are expected to be completed by the end of this month (June 2023).
