## Heard and McDonald Islands batteries for home power

Where are Heard Island and McDonald Islands located?

The islands are a territory (Territory of Heard Island and McDonald Islands) of Australia Aministered from Hobart by the Australian Antarctic Division of the Australian Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water.

#### How big is Heard Island & McDonald Islands?

The group's overall land area is 372 km 2 (144 sq mi)and it has 101.9 km (63 mi) of coastline. Discovered in the mid-19th century,the islands lie on the Kerguelen Plateau in the Indian Ocean and have been an Australian territory since 1947. Heard Island and McDonald Islands contain Australia's only two active volcanoes.

#### Are there spiders on Heard Island?

The arthropods of Heard Island are comparatively well known with 54 species of mite and tick, one spiderand eight springtails recorded. A study over summer at Atlas Cove in 1987/88 showed overall densities of up to 60 000 individual springtails per square metre in soil under stands of Pringlea antiscorbutica.

#### Does Heard Island have a wetland?

Heard Island has a number of small wetland sitesscattered around its coastal perimeter, including areas of wetland vegetation, lagoons or lagoon complexes, rocky shores and sandy shores, including the Elephant Spit. Many of these wetland areas are separated by active glaciers. There are also several short glacier-fed streams and glacial pools.

#### What insects live on Heard Island?

Beetles and fliesdominate Heard Island's known insect fauna, which comprises up to 21 species of ectoparasite (associated with birds and seals) and up to 13 free-living species.

#### Why is Heard Island a low flora?

Heard Island supports a relatively low number of terrestrial invertebrate species compared to other Southern Ocean islands,in parallel with the low species richness in the flora-that is,the island's isolation and limited ice-free area.
