The Territory of Heard Island and McDonald Islands (HIMI) is a group of barren volcanic Antarctic Islands located in the Indian Ocean. It is almost juxtaposed in nature with a dormant volcano residing under sheets of glaciers surrounded by turbulent stormy waters.

Heard Island is 43 km long and 21 km wide. McDonald Islands are a group of uninhabited rocky islets, 40 km west of Heard Island (Encyclopaedia Britannica 2006).Heard Island has approximately 362.5 km 2 of area and the McDonald Island, 2.6 km 2.The site includes the adjacent offshore rocks and shoals and all territorial waters to a distance of 12 nautical ...

Private vessels are known to visit Heard Island (and likely to visit McDonald Islands) with no biosecurity assessment, implementation or enforcement. Sailing vessels depart from South Africa and the South African and/or French sub-antarctic islands en route to Heard Island and are considered a high biosecurity risk (IUCN Consultation, 2020b).

The McDonald Islands are small, rocky and actively volcanic. The islands are populated by large numbers of seal and bird species, and have been designated a nature reserve. There are 4 types of penguins that are located on Heard Island. With the only two active volcanoes in Australian territory the islands are situated on the Kerguelen Plateau.
