Why do people install solar panels?

Increasing household electricity bills are a large motivator for the installation of residential solar systems. Furthermore, the Inflation Reduction Act, passed in August 2022, modified and extended clean energy investment tax credits, with households able to save up to 30 percent in their solar installation until 2032.

How many Americans have already installed solar panels?

A January Pew Research Center survey found that 8% of U.S. homeowners said they have already installed solar panels and an additional 39% have given serious thought to it in the past year. The survey was conducted before the 30% federal tax credit became law in August.

How much does a solar panel installation cost?

The average installation cost of a residential solar panel system so far this year can range from \$16,870 to \$23,170 after applying the federal solar tax credit, according to EnergySage, though other factors, such as the type of solar panel, can affect the price.

What percentage of homeowners have installed solar panels?

The share of homeowners who say they have installed solar panels is up from 6% in a 2019 survey and 4% in 2016. But the share who said in January that they have given serious thought to installing solar panels is down 7 percentage points from 2019.
