Coin lockers at Shinjuku Station can be found throughout the enormous complex of the main JR Shinjuku Station as well as its satellite rail, subway and bus stations including the Odakyu and Keio railways.

Do you need a locker in Japan?

Do not rely upon the availability of lockers and have a back-up plan or back-up station for your luggage storage. The majority of lockers in Japan are only available for day use, with items removed at a set time -- although some lockers allow patrons to store items for 36, 48, or 72 hours, depending on the location.

Where are the lockers in Tokyo & Shinjuku?

Tokyo Station: Lockers concentrated in the Marunouchi Central Gate area (inside and outside the paid area), plus the underground B1F passage and Yaesu South Gate. Shinjuku Station: Banks of lockers all over the sprawling station, with key areas being the East and West Exit ticket gates, underground plazas, and passageways.

Unlike at airports where luggage can be stored over multiple days, the storage counters at stations often require same-day pick-up. Coin lockers come in various sizes and can be found at virtually every train station and at the entrances to ...
