

## How long can cat food be stored in the rice bucket and rice storage box

How long should cat food last?

The type of cat food. Dry food, once opened, should be used within two-to-three months if properly stored, while wet food should be used within three days if sealed and refrigerated. Whether the food has been opened. Once a cat food bag or can has been opened, the "best by" date is no longer a reference point.

How do you store cat food?

How the cat food is stored. Before opening, elements such as temperature can affect the nutritional quality of cat food. Store dry food and unopened wet food in a dry place where the temperature is below 80 degrees.

Can you store cat food on a porch?

Do not store cat food on the porch, in the garage or in the trunk of your car. Before opening dry food, check the bag for tears, holes, mold, or other signs that the food may have been exposed to air or moisture. Cans of cat food should be sealed tight, and not appear swollen or bulging.

Can you put dry cat food in another storage container?

If you need to pour dry cat food into another storage container because the original package has become torn or damaged, make sure the container is clean and perfectly dry, and has an airtight lid, says Dr. Gary Weitzman, CEO of the San Diego Humane Society.

Can you store cat food in a ziploc bag?

Ziploc bags are good moisture barriers but do not provide good oxygen and odor barriers." Extreme temperatures (too hot or too cold) and high humidity can cause cat food to degrade or spoil. Store cat food in the house in a cool, dry, dark place like your pantry. Do not store cat food on the porch, in the garage or in the trunk of your car.

Does cat food need to be refrigerated?

Once opened, wet cat food must be refrigerated. Some commercial food companies state that opened canned food might last as long as five to seven days when stored in the fridge in an airtight container. However, it's best to use leftover wet food within 72 hours.
