

# How to remove the door of the energy storage cabinet

How to remove cabinet doors?

Most cabinet doors are connected to the cabinet frame with hinges. To remove cabinet doors, you simply need to unscrew the hinge hardware connecting the doors to the cabinet frame. The doors can then be lifted off. Below we will go step-by-step on how to properly remove both face frame and frameless cabinet doors.

How do you remove cabinet door hinges?

Concealed hinges are the easiest to remove. For concealed cabinet door hinges: Fully open the cabinet door. On the inside cabinet wall, locate the screws that connect the hinge plate to the cabinet frame. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the screws and remove the hinge plate from the cabinet side.

How do you clean a kitchen cabinet?

With all the doors removed, take down your labels and thoroughly wipe down the cabinet boxes and doors. Carefully remove any old caulk, nails, or screws from the cabinet face frames. Use a plastic putty knife to scrape off debris. Then clean with a damp sponge and mild detergent. Fully dry all surfaces.

How do you remove a butt cabinet door?

For doors with butt cabinet door hinges: Fully open the cabinet door. Unscrew the pins from both leaves of the butt hinge using a screwdriver. This allows the two halves to detach. Lift the door off the cabinets. For continuous hinges, unscrew the leaf on the cabinet frame. Bend the hinge back and forth to pop the pins loose and detach the door.

How do you open a concealed cabinet door?

For concealed cabinet door hinges: Fully open the cabinet door. On the inside cabinet wall, locate the screws that connect the hinge plate to the cabinet frame. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the screws and remove the hinge plate from the cabinet side. Then open the door slightly wider than 90 degrees.
