How to install a solar panel?

The first step is to attach the fixing bracket to the solar panel. Lay the solar panel face-down on the tarp or canvas to protect the photovoltaic surface. You want to be sure the mounting holes on the back of the panel align with the holes in the fixing bracket. Don't modify the module frame because doing so may void your manufacturer's warranty.

What happens if you over tighten a solar panel?

Over-tightening or Under-tightening Example: During the installation of solar panels, if fasteners are overtightened, it may result in deformation or breakage of the solar panel glass or frame. Conversely, if under-tightened, it could lead to solar panels detaching or shifting during strong winds or vibrations. Specific Solutions:
