

How many MW solar power has been installed in India?

The Union Minister for New & Renewable Energy and Power has informed that as on 30.06.2023, a cumulative solar power capacity of 70,096 MW has been installed in the country. The State/UT-wise details of cumulative solar capacity installed are as given below.

What is India's solar energy potential?

The installed solar energy capacity has increased by 30 times in the last 9 years and stands at 87.2 GW as of Jul 2024. India's solar energy potential is estimated to be 748 GW as estimated by National Institute of Solar Energy (NISE). The installed Renewable energy capacity (including large hydro) has increased by around 128% since 2014.

How much solar power has India added in 2023?

In 2023, India has added 7.5 GW of solar power capacity. During January 2024, the capacity addition from solar energy stood at 9008.47 MW. Solar power accounted for 16.9% of the total installed power capacity and 40.1% of the total installed renewable capacity at the end of December 2023.

How much solar energy has India generated in 2022-23?

The generation during 2022-23 was 1624.158 BU as compared to 1491.859 BU generated during 2021-22, representing a growth of about 8.87%. The installed solar energy capacity has increased by 26 times in the last 9 years and stands at 73.32 GW as of December 2023. In 2023, India has added 7.5 GW of solar power capacity.

What percentage of India's electricity is produced by solar power?

Solar power constitutes 18% of India's total installed electricity but only 6.66% of the power produced, highlighting a gap between capacity and actual output. Renewables, including solar and wind power, accounted for 30% of global electricity production in 2023, with China being the main contributor.

Will India's solar energy capacity reach unprecedented levels?

During his address at the India Today Conclave, Prime Minister Narendra Modi outlined ambitious plans for the next five years, particularly in solar energy. He expressed confidence that India's solar energy capacity would reach unprecedented levels in the coming years. But is that assertion grounded in reality?

Currently, India has an installed solar power of around 73 GW, according to ICRA. New solar capacity additions in fiscal year 2024 and fiscal year 2025 are estimated at 17 GW and 20 GW, respectively.
