

What is Ireland's energy security package?

This energy security package sets out a strategic approach to ensure a secure transition for Ireland's energy systems in line with its climate objectives. It considers lessons, in particular, from the disruption to European energy supplies following the invasion of Ukraine and the domestic capacity shortfall experienced in the electricity sector.

How many energy credits are there in Ireland?

The EUR250 energy credit for every household was announced in Budget 2025 and will be paid in two instalments of EUR125 each. Every home across Ireland is set to receive EUR250 worth of energy credits - with Budget 2025 rolling out the relief in two EUR125 payments.

What will Ireland's energy supply look like in 2022?

Petrol demand may be 7.4% higher than in 2022 and reach 96.5% of the pre-COVID demand observed in 2019. Transport emissions may be 11.8 MtCO₂e, up slightly on 2022 emissions. In the first 9 months of 2023, Ireland imported 9.1% of its electricity supply, up from 1.1% in 2022.

How much electricity did Ireland import in 2023?

In the first 9 months of 2023, Ireland imported 9.1% of its electricity supply, up from 1.1% in 2022. The increased use of imported electricity has significantly reduced Ireland's electricity emissions. Electricity emissions may be 7.3 MtCO₂e, down significantly on 2022 emissions.

Will Ireland's future energy be secure?

The report sets out that Ireland's future energy will be secure by moving from an oil- and gas-based energy system to an electricity-led system, maximising our renewable energy potential, flexibility and being integrated into Europe's energy systems.

Ireland's national energy-related emissions in 2023 were at their lowest level in over 30 years. Energy-related emissions in 2023 were 31.4 MtCO₂eq, down 8.3% on 2022-levels. Electricity accounted for a 24.1% of energy emissions, transport for 37.6% and heat for 38.3%.
