Germany's Development Bank KfW financed the EUR40 millionproject with EUR27 million through the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development. The European Union added EUR9.7 million,and the government of Ivory Coast contributed the remaining sum.

Ivory Coast aims to increase its installed power capacity to 3.5 GW by 2025 and 8.6 GW by 2040. As part of this strategy, the country's Ministry of Mines, Petroleum and Energy signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with renewable energy company Kong Solaire earlier this month to construct a 50 MW solar power

plant in the Tchologo region.

Egyptian firm Elsewedy Electric, Cairo-based Infinity Power Holding and Morocco's Nareva Holding feature prominently among potential developers for the Laboa and Touba projects. Selected bidders have until August 9, 2024, to submit proposals to the Ivorian Ministry of Mines, Petroleum and Energy and state-owned entity Côte d'Ivoire ...

The selected IPPs will build solar photovoltaic power plants capable of delivering 60 MW to the Ivory Coast's national grid. These projects are in line with Ivory Coast's target to generate 42% of its electricity from renewable energy by 2030.

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The government of Côte d'Ivoire collaborates with PFO AFRICA in a historic initiative, signing agreements for a 52 MWp photovoltaic solar power plant. In Ivory Coast, 10 multinational companies have been qualified following a call for tenders to build two photovoltaic solar power plants under a public-private partnership (PPP) in the Bafing region. The plants will be built under the World Bank's Scaling Solar programme.
