In the Malagasy language, the island of Madagascar is called Madagasikara (Malagasy pronunciation: [madagasj'kjar?]) and its people are referred to as Malagasy. The origin of the name is uncertain, and is likely foreign, having been propagated in the Middle Ages by Europeans.

When did Madagascar become a colony?

Madagascar was a pirate stronghold during the late 17th and early 18th centuries and served as a slave trading center into the 19th century. From the 16th to the late 19th century,a native Merina Kingdom dominated much of Madagascar. The French conquered the island in 1896and made it a colony; independence was regained in 1960.
