What is Masdar doing in Mauritania?

The power plant is one of numerous worldwide initiatives supported by Masdar. Mauritanian utility (SOMELEC) issued a request for proposals, and the Vergnet-ABC Diesel pool was chosen to deliver the hybrid power plant projectin Mauritania. It will be the first of its kind in the sub-region of West Africa.

The Toujounine project was the first major low-carbon-power project to use solar energy in Mauritania. Completed in 2017 and sponsored by Solemec, Mauritania's national electric company, the project is an impressive \$53 million solar farm boasting 53,000 solar panels.
