

Is Mauritania a sustainable country?

Mauritania is making great strides in the realm of renewable energy. Their commitment to a sustainable future is evident in their increasing use of natural resources to generate electricity. In 2008, a mere 1% of electricity came from renewable sources, but by 2020, that number had grown to an impressive 37%.

Mauritania, with its abundant wind and solar energy, has committed to the African Green Hydrogen Alliance and the UN's High-Level Champions for Climate Action. In May 2021, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed to develop the 30GW AMAN green hydrogen project, which is estimated to increase the country's GDP by 50% by 2030.
