

Will China build a solar power plant in Saudi Arabia?

BEIJING, Aug 13 (Reuters) - China Energy Engineering (601868.SS) signed a 6.98 billion yuan (\$972 million) contract to build a solar power plant in Saudi Arabia, a Monday filing with the Shanghai Stock Exchange, marking the latest in a string of China-Saudi renewable energy deals.

Why did CSAIL buy Alcazar energy?

The acquisition of Alcazar Energy's portfolio of seven wind and solar projects across Jordan and Egypt with a total generation capacity of 411 megawatts will give CSAIL and the other Chinese investors access to the Mena region and help expand their presence. The terms of the deal were not disclosed.

Alcazar estimates that 157 gigawatts of renewable energy capacity will be added to the sector and \$175 billion will be invested in the next ten years.
