Currently, solar power plants providing a total of 160 mW are located in Bavet city, Svay Rieng province, Kampong Speu province, and Kampong Chhnang province. Cambodia's existing solar power stations are already generating energy and linked to the grids.

Is Cambodia a solar power hotspot?

Cambodia's geographical location and climate conditions position it as a solar power hotspot with potential that surpasses many of its regional neighbours. Studies show that the country receives a daily solar irradiance of 5 kWh per square m and an average of eight hours of sunlight daily.

Cambodia is suited perfectly for solar power because you get so many peak sun hours. Located 1500 Km (900 mi) north of the equator means intense, high in the sky sunlight for almost 6 hours a day. A "peak sun hour" is defined as an hour of sunlight that offers 1,000 watts of photovoltaic power per square meter.
