Papua New Guinea enjoyed 15 years of almost uninterrupted, if fluctuating, economic growth from 2003 until 2017. Since 2016 growth has been subdued, erratic and, for 2018 (with a major earthquake) and 2020, with the Covid19 pandemic, negative, with non-mining growth sluggish since 2015. Formal sector employment has been subdued.

In PNG, USAID's PNG Lukautim Graun Program supported a years-long process for civil society groups in PNG to establish a new environmental CSO peak body organization called the PNG Environment Alliance or PNGEA that helps consolidate environmental advocacy positions and strengthen CSOs across the country.
