

Is Russia targeting Ukraine's energy facilities?

Russia launched a missile attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure early Friday, in an assault that President Volodymyr Zelensky described as "one of the largest strikes" on his country's power facilities.

Did Russia launch a new attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure overnight?

Russia launched a new widespread attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure overnight, forcing the country to implement emergency power outages, Ukrainian authorities said on Friday.

Did Russia's renewed attacks on energy infrastructure damage Ukraine's nuclear reactors?

The agency said after Friday's attack that five of Ukraine's nine operating nuclear reactors had to reduce their power output because of Russia's "renewed attacks on energy infrastructure." The first reports of damage after the assault came from western Ukraine.

As a major producer and exporter of both oil and natural gas, Russia has a significant role in global energy markets. Russia's invasion of Ukraine on 24 February 2022 has potentially serious implications for international energy security.

How much does electricity cost in Russia?

At the same time, Russia has one of the lowest residential electricity prices, at only 0.06 U.S. dollars per kilowatt-hour. Thus, the country's households paid for electricity nearly seven times less than in Germany and the United Kingdom (UK).

How did Russia affect Europe's energy transition?

Although the immediate post-invasion desperation to be less vulnerable to Russian energy dominance triggered a massive effort in Europe to replace fossil fuels with renewables, advancing the energy transition by years, the cheap oil and gas Russia in turn made available to China, India, and Turkey set those countries' transitions back just as much.
