World Bank funding will be used to build these structures that will then be used as platforms for solar panels that will feed solar power into MEC"s distribution grid. Roofs of schools and government buildings, as well as the airport reservoirs will be used to install thousands of solar panels.

The project helped Marshall Energy Company to upgrade the existing No. 1 power station, build a roof and reservoir floating photovoltaic power generation system, and provide it with an additional battery energy storage system to support the new photovoltaic power generation system.
