

Does Sao Tome & Principe have solar power?

According to data from the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), Sao Tome and Principe did not have any grid-connected solar generation capacity installed at the end of 2021. The World Bank says Sao Tome and Principe has an electricity access rate of around 76%, with 92% of the total coming from imported diesel.

Is EMAE dragging down the economy of Sao Tomé & Príncipe?

The troubles afflicting utility EMAE are dragging down the economy of the island nation. The United Nations Development Program is seeking consultants to conduct feasibility studies for a 2 MW solar project and three mini hydropower plants ranging in size from 1.15-2 MW in São Tomé & Príncipe.

Where will solar power plants be installed in Sao Tomé & Príncipe?

The company will collaborate with the public utility Power and Water Company (EMAE) to install solar power plants across the country. The first phase of the program will include the installation of solar PV plants at the São Tomé & Príncipe international airport, as well as on the island of Príncipe, with capacities of 1.1 kW and 300 kW, respectively.
