Can you buy a solar energy system with a mortgage?

New homeowners can add solar as part of their mortgage with loans available through the Federal Housing Administration Fannie Mae, which allow borrowers to include financing for home improvements in the home's purchase price. Buying a solar energy system makes you eligible for the Solar Investment Tax Credit, or ITC.

How do I Go Solar for my home?

The most common way to go solar for homeowners is the installation of panels on their roofs. These systems can be purchased directly through an installer (or assembled for the DIYers) as a large cash purchase or through relatively affordable financing (such as a 1.99% APR 15-year loan).

How much does a solar energy system cost?

A home solar energy system costs about \$13,400 after the 30% federal tax credit and typically saves around \$1,500 annually. The installation cost of solar panels and electricity bill savings depend on local electricity rates, the solar company you choose, how much sunlight your roof gets, and the rebates and tax incentives available near you.
