

How much does electricity cost in Solomon Islands?

Not only is energy in the country unreliable, it is expensive. Energy in Solomon Islands costs an average of US\$0.58 per kilowatt hour. At this price, a family in Honiara using 250 watts for 8 hours a day would have to pay over US\$1 a day for electricity.

What percentage of Solomon Islanders have access to power?

On top of the cost, according to advocacy groups only about 15 to 20 per cent of Solomon Islanders have access to power. For Solomon Islands' MP Peter Kenilorea, it is a major roadblock in the country's economic growth and "not something to be proud of".

Is biomass a source of electricity in Solomon Islands?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. Solomon Islands: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power? Nuclear power - alongside renewables - is a low-carbon source of electricity.
