

How many units can a 3KW Solar System produce?

How many solar panels do you need for a 3KW system?

The number of solar panels you need for a 3kW system depends on the wattage of your solar panels, but you'll likely need eight to 10 panels if you go with the kinds of panels normally used for residential applications.

How big is a 3 kW solar system?

Residential solar panels are around 3 feet across by 5 feet tall, totaling 15 square feet. This means a 3 kW installation composed of 12 panels has a footprint of around 180 square feet. Although some people live in homes that are 180 square feet, it's really not that big (heck, it's called a tiny home for a reason).
