

Does Syria need a 'credible & non-sectarian governance' after Bashar al-Assad's rule?

British Prime Minister Keir Starmer said on Friday caution was needed regarding Syria's prospects after the end of Bashar al-Assad's rule and that the country required "credible, inclusive and non-sectarian governance on behalf of all Syrians";

Can Hayat Tahrir al-Sham unite Syrians?

In Idlib, Hayat Tahrir al-Sham has espoused a government guided by a conservative and at times hard-line Sunni Islamist ideology. The Israeli Air Force over the weekend was also carried out airstrikes in Syria. The targets included small stockpiles of chemical weapons, primarily mustard gas and the nerve gas VX, which remained in Syrian possession despite prior agreements to disarm, according to Israeli officials.

Ukraine, a global producer and exporter of grain and oilseeds, is ready to supply food to Syria following the fall of Bashar al-Assad, Ukrainian Agriculture Minister Vitaliy Koval told Reuters on Friday.

Will Syria's armed opposition form a 'council chosen by the people'?

Syria's armed opposition ultimately plans to form a government defined by institutions and a "council chosen by the people," Jolani told CNN.
