Electricity sector in Taiwan is regulated by its state-owned electric power utility company Taiwan Power Company(Taipower),established on 1 May 1946. After the liberalization of Taiwan electricity market in January 1995,there are total of 9 independent power producers in Taiwan up to date,which are:

As of 2007,Taiwan had a total of 78power plants,which are 39 hydro power plants,27 thermal power plants,9 wind farms and 3 nuclear power plants. As of 2015, electricity consumption was projected to grow by 1.9% annually. Northern Taiwan consumes 40% of the total power generated in Taiwan, and it generally imports power transmitted from Central Taiwan and Southern Taiwan.
