

Which operators are active in Togo?

In Togo two operators are active: Togocel (by Togo Telecom) and Moov (by Maroc Telecom). Both networks broadcast on 900 MHz for 2G and 2100 MHz for 3G. In summer 2017 4G/LTE licenses were issued to the two operators and Togocel and Moov both launched their 4G/LTE network in Lomé; in June 2018.
