

Solar panel costs can vary significantly from state to state in Australia, influenced by local factors including climate conditions, government policies, and market competition. A report published by the International Renewable Energy Agency, also known as IRENA, revealed the overall costs for residential solar PV systems in Australia (including both installation and operation) had fallen by over 50% between 2010 and 2014, from \$US0.35 down to \$US0.17 per kilowatt-hour.

The below table shows the average solar panel cost by city & size of solar panels installed (DC). The prices in all the below tables include the up-front incentive available for small-scale systems through the Renewable Energy Target (i.e. "STC discount") and GST - they represent the total retail price of the system to the customer .

After applying government incentives in 2024, a typical 6kW solar panel system in Australia can range from around \$4,000 to \$6,000. This is a significant reduction compared to just a few years ago. Here's a ballpark range for commonly installed system sizes:
