Wallis (Wallisian: ?Uvea) is a Polynesian atoll/island in the Pacific Ocean belonging to the French overseas collectivity (collectivité d"outre-mer, or COM) of Wallis and Futuna. It lies north of Tonga, northeast of Fiji, east-northeast of the Hoorn Islands, east of Fiji's Rotuma, southeast of Tuvalu, southwest of Tokelau and west of Samoa.

Wallis- och Futunaöarna (franska Îles Wallis et Futuna, walliska och östfutuna Uvea mo Futuna), formellt på svenska Territoriet Wallis- och Futunaöarna [1]) är ett franskt territorium i sydvästra Stilla havet.Huvudort är Mata-Utu.. Wallis and Futuna was the only French colony to side with the Vichy regime during World War II until the arrival of Free French and US troops in 1942. In 1959, inhabitants of the islands voted to separate from New Caledonia and become a French overseas territory, a status it assumed in 1961.
