How much solar irradiation will the Faroe Islands produce in 2021?

The Faroe Islands are isolated from their nearest neighbors by hundreds of kilometers. Nevertheless, this small nation is setting an example for the entire world with its progress towards reaching an audacious goal: 100% sustainable energy by 2030.

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The first field solar PV plant in the Faroe Islands has been inaugurated. It is located on an abandoned football field in the village of Sumba, the southern most village on the southern most island of Suðuroy. The 250 kWp plant, which is expected to generate approximately 160 MWh pr. year, is a test site, albeit not a big one.

In 2030 the electricity sector in the Faroe Islands should be 100% renewable, according to the local electrical power company SEV. It is therefore necessary to study, how this goal can be reached with the minimum costs. This can be determined through optimisation of the future electricity sector.
