### What is Western Sahara DLC?

Western Sahara is the first Creator DLCto feature a setting that takes place within ArmA 3's mid-2030s era. It is also the first Creator DLC to add a desert terrain to ArmA 3 (albeit only in a semi-official capacity).

### What happens if Western Sahara is loaded at the same time?

If Western Sahara is loaded at the same time with another 2030s Armaverse Creator DLC, Reaction Forces, various factions in Western Sahara will automatically have some weapons and vehicles from the latter's asset pool integrated. For instance, helicopters and pickup trucks from Reaction Forces will be "added" to the ION PMC, SFIA and Tura factions.

## Does Western Sahara have phosphate reserves?

Aside from its rich fishing waters and phosphate reserves, Western Sahara has few natural resources and lacks sufficient rainfall and freshwater resources for most agricultural activities. Western Sahara's much-touted phosphate reserves are relatively unimportant, representing less than two percent of proven phosphate reserves in Morocco.

The first phase of the Hubei Zaoyang Storage Integration Demonstration Project will be a 3MW / 12MWh vanadium redox flow battery (VRB) in Zaoyang, Hubei Province. The battery storage system will be used to assist the integration of power from large-scale photovoltaics (PV) locally.

Commissioning has taken place of a 100MW/400MWh vanadium redox flow battery (VRFB) energy storage system in Dalian, China. The biggest project of its type in the world today, the VRFB project's planning, design and construction has taken six years.

The initial stages of another renewable energy project has been launched in the disputed Western Sahara region, which is under the control of Morocco. The Janassim project recently launched its measuring campaign of solar and wind energy potential.
