How do I protect my solar panels from damage during shipping?

To protect solar panels during shipping, follow these instructions: Inspect the solar panel before shipping for any obvious damage. During packing, place the sunny side (front side) facing the pallet. Add foam pads around the frame of the solar panel. Have the last solar panel sunny side up. Lastly, add edge protectors.

How to transport photovoltaic panels?

Photovoltaic panels should be transported in transparent packages so that any defects can be noticed without damaging the packaging film. It is best to stack the modules vertically to reduce the pressure of a single panel. There should be separators between the panels. Properly separated, the panels are protected against breakage during transport.
