Why is Zimbabwe focusing on renewables?

Zimbabwe's focus on renewables comes as it attempts to lessen its reliance on energy imports and improve access to electricity, as World Bank data shows that just 49% of the country had access in 2021. The country still faces significant power deficits, which contribute to regular power outages.

Will Zimbabwe have a green hydrogen power plant?

Plans for Zimbabwe's first utility-scale green hydrogen power plant, with 178 GWh of expected annual electricity production, were finalized in March 2023.
